Dear Friends!

WELCOME TO FEBRUARY, THE MONTH OF LOVE!!

Yes, in our church, we not only celebrate Valentine's Day on Feb. 14, but we also celebrate the entire month as the Month of LOVE!!

Charles Fillmore, Co-Founder of Unity included LOVE as one of the 12 powers or talents or capabilities that we ALL have within us, and, as we develop them to the fullest, so do we find that we are experiencing the fullness of the Christ life that we ALL were created to experience.

We want to be sure that we explain that we are talking about the Unconditional, Divine LOVE that Jesus taught us about 2,000 or so years ago. We are not talking about being a church of “free love” as many people were involved with in the 50's and 60's, but the church of Unconditional Love that our Master taught.

NOT BOASTFUL	BELIEVES ALL THINGS
DOES NOT INSIST ON ITS OWN WAY	HOPES ALL THINGS
NOT IRRITABLE OR RESENTFUL	and ENDURES ALL THINGS

We can see from the above, that LOVE is SOOOO much more than we are thinking of when we consider relationship love. If we REALLY are expressing UNCONDITIONAL LOVE, We are allowing the Goodness of God to express through us and every activity that we undertake. This may be what we are considering when we use the wonderful affirmation from Catherine Ponder: “I LIVE BY THE LAW OF LOVE AND LOVE IS NOW VICTORIOUS”. When we allow those 12 characteristics of LOVE to permeate our lives, we find that ONLY GOOD can happen!!

The checking account balance, including deposits in transit and outstanding checks, was \$(3,898.95) at the beginning of December and \$26.77 at the end of the month, a net increase of \$3,925.72. Please note that the operating loss above reflects \$7,120.00 of debt owed to Rev. Dean based on the contract signed at the December board meeting.

The savings account balance was \$843.32 at the beginning of December and \$883.54 at the end of the month, reflecting the \$1,740.00 of deposits for the Let the Light Shine In fundraising campaign, \$1,700.00 transfer to checking for payment to Mainstream, and \$0.22 in interest income.

RULES OF UNITY GOOD WORDS CLUB

3. Members are expected to report once a month to the Central Secretary. (All that will be required is a mere statement to the effect that the member is trying and is succeeding in replacing idle words with good ones.)
4. Each member is to secure at least one new member each year. (Extra blanks for new members to fill out will be sent upon application.) The pledge must be signed personally by the one joining.

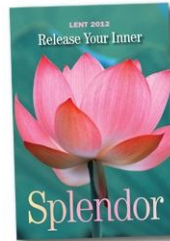
